#### Former SAS MEMBER'S ASHES launched into Outer Space

About a teaspoon of ashes of Kay Heggestad, a SAS member from 2008 thru 2016, were launched into Space on Monday January 8, 2024 aboard a capsule on the Vulcan rocket that took off with Astrobotic's Peregrine lander from Cape Canaveral Space Force Station in Florida destined for a moon landing on February 23. However the moon landing was thwarted by a "critical" fuel leak that led to complications in battery charging aboard the lander. While this had been repaired, it is estimated that it's power could only operate for 40 more hours. Several days later, it was reported that the space craft had burned up in outer space,

However, other of her ashes may still have the opportunity to make it to the moon. Celestis, a company that launches cremated remains into space has a performance guarantee that provides a no cost reflight for clients in the event the mission does not reach the intended destination and has already collected sufficient flight samples to do so, from their clients.

Kay, and her husband Paul Wertch, both physicians and lovers of Star Trek and Space, cofounded Wildwood Clinic's of Madison and Cottage Grove. She died in 2017. Along with Kay's ashes were five Scientific instruments from NASA and 15 other payloads from various organizations and countries including hair samples from George Washington, John F. Kennedy, Dwight Eisenhower and Ronald Reagan as well as ashes of "Star Trek" creator Gene Roddenberry, his wife, and a few astronauts and authors.

During her eight year membership in SAS, Kay's interests included Pickleball, Tennis, Volley Ball, and Walking.
